Our Gala Dinner & Auction raised over \$52,000 in Sept. 2012 with the help of Honourary Chair Mayor Mel Norton, Committee Chair David Levangie, Emcee Patrick Gallagher, and Auctioneer Tim Maloney who kept everyone well entertained. Many, many dedicated volunteers sold tickets and helped set up

hundreds of auction items including trips, a diamond ring, and a dozen artworks by well-known local artists.

Since 2007, \$225,000 has been raised toward the Wardrobe Project, with 48 completed on Garden Court. Phase II will see new wardrobes on Hopewell Court. An additional \$375,000 is needed to complete the project. These necessary upgrades, which are not funded by the Government, provide residents with great pride and joy in their "home away from home" at Rocmaura.


