Because You Cared...

Ken Isaac found a sense of peace during his last years living at Rocmaura Nursing Home.

The Saint John man, who had become a solo pilot at the age of 16 and was studying to become an engineer, was in his early 20s when he developed schizophrenia.

For years, Isaac was in and out of institutions and special care homes, some far outside the city. But when his health needs increased and he became bedridden, his family sought a nursing home, which could give him the care he required and be in proximity to his family members.

"As a family, we always took care of Ken," said his brother and well-known antiques dealer and auctioneer Tim Isaac, "But we were very fortunate Rocmaura received him as a resident."

Coincidentally, Tim was well acquainted with Rocmaura by the time his brother called it home.

Since 1998, he had served as its auctioneer at the foundation's annual gala – an event that raises money to provide improved resident services and programs.

It's a role he will assume again on Sept. 21.

"The money is not there like it used to be years ago from government," he said. "Today, it is the foundation that raises the extra money to make residents more comfortable."

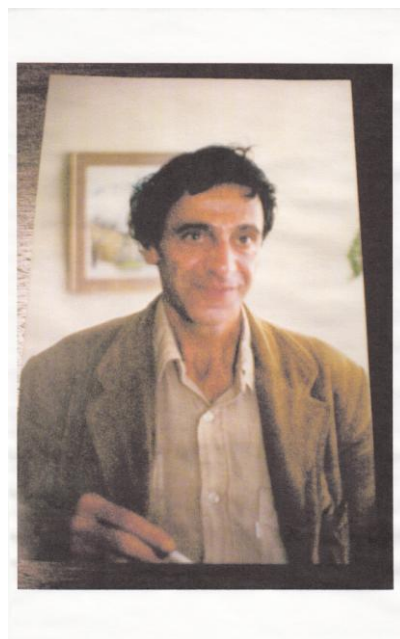
Because of Rocmaura Nursing Home, the Isaac family is forever grateful for the care given to Ken, who died in 2010 at the age of 71.

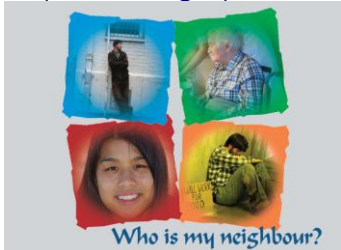
