This Agreement witnesses that the Nursing Home and the Visitor wish to enter into an agreement respecting process and understandings of their relationship. The Visitor agrees to abide by the conditions as outlined in this Agreement:

SCREENING

The Visitor shall agree to be subject to active screening upon entry of the Nursing Home for every visit. The Visitor shall not be permitted to enter the Nursing Home for a visit if they fall under one of the following categories:

- Answer "yes" to any of the screening questions
- Have any symptoms or feeling unwell
- Are on self-isolation per relevant Public Health directives
- Have had close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- Have had close contact with someone awaiting test results of COVID-19

The Visitor must notify the Nursing Home of any symptoms that arise within 14 days of a visit.

The Visitor acknowledges that they read and understand Safe Visiting Practices, attached as "Appendix A".

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT & SOCIAL DISTANCING

The Visitor acknowledges that they have been instructed on and understand the required personal protective equipment that is required during their visit. The Visitor undertakes to wear a mask, and any other protective equipment required by the Nursing Home, continually, both indoors and outdoors, to the best of their ability when visiting. The Visitor acknowledges that they have been educated on and understand principles of social distancing and will do their best to maintain physical distancing when possible.

REVOCATION OF AGREEMENT

Entry on Nursing Home premises may be refused or privileges in this Agreement may be revoked by the Nursing Home if there is reason to believe the Visitor is not abiding by the conditions as set out in this Agreement.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

When visiting the Nursing Home, the Visitor shall proceed directly to the location of their visit. While in the Nursing Home, the Visitor shall wear an ID-Badge supplied by the Nursing Home at all times.

The Visitor understands the risks posed to residents and staff of the nursing home should they not abide by nursing home policies and Public Health measures. The Visitor shall make their best effort to follow Nursing Home policies and Public Health measures and will ask questions if they require clarification on any of the policies or measures.

EXPOSURE WAIVER

The Visitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Nursing Home against any or all claims, actions suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities arising out of, connected with, or resulting from any potential COVID-19 exposure that may occur in the Nursing Home. The Visitor hereby releases the Nursing Home and its personnel from any and all such liability, and the Visitor understands that this release shall be binding upon the Visitor's estate, heirs, representatives and assigns.

GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of New Brunswick, Canada applicable to contracts entered into and performed within the Province of New Brunswick, Canada.

"APPENDIX A"

SAFE VISITING PRACTICES

Hand Hygiene

All persons visiting, including the residents, must wash their hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer, before, during as appropriate, and after all visits.

Use of PPE – General Practices

All Visitors are required to wear a mask (medical) continuously and be instructed how to put on and take off that mask and any other PPE that may be required.

Use of PPE to Enable Safe Physical Touch

The risk of transmission of COVID-19 increases with close proximity. If a resident and their Visitor understands this and they wish to include physical touch in their visits, this may be done by the following additional guidance:

- Immediately stop close contact with resident and inform staff if they are or become symptomatic during the visit.
- Continuously wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth.
- Though a resident does not need to also wear a mask, they may choose to do so.
- Perform hand hygiene (hand washing and/or use of alcohol-based hand sanitizer) both before and after direct physical contact with the resident.

Residents on Isolation Precautions

- Residents who are suspect cases of COVID-19, who are on isolation precautions, will not be permitted to have any visitation.
- Residents who are on isolation precautions for other reasons (e.g. norovirus, or influenza) may have a Visitor visit, at Rocmaura Inc.'s discretion. Required PPE (based on precaution) must be worn by Visitor at all times.
